SUBJECT: Use of Envirotac II on Ammo Supply Point Access Road, CSC Scania

- During a recent rainstorm, the main access road to our ammo supply point was
 washed out impacting mission response time and creating an unsafe condition for
 heavy vehicles navigating the site. Using Envirotac II already pre-staged at our site
 for dust and erosion control, our engineers were able to use locally available
 aggregate to restore the washed out sections and create a stable embankment. The
 road was also re-formed using the product after a new sub-base was installed.
- 2. We were very fortunate that Envirotac II was on site to allow a rapid response to this mission impacting situation. Once mobilized, the entire work of repairing, stabilizing and re-surfacing the road (approximately 250 meters) took only four days using onhand assets. The fast curing of the product allowed mission operations to commence on the fifth day. To date there has been no deterioration of the road surface even with daily heavy vehicle operations.
